



Cloth Mask with Halyard filter

Our goal:

The **Free Mask Project of Vancouver** has designed a cloth mask with filter in collaboration with the Vancouver sewing community and UBC researchers. The cloth materials and mask design have been selected to maximize breathability and protection against COVID-19.

Each package contains:

- A 2-layer cloth mask with filter pocket and nose-piece pocket
- 2 Halyard filters (1 is already inserted into the mask)
- 1 removable aluminum nose piece (already inserted)
- 1 Adjustable elastic to loop around the head

How to wear the mask:

1. Insert the filter through the bottom opening into the filter pocket
2. Adjust the nose piece to fit your nose
3. Pull the bottom elastic loop over the head and neck and leave it around the neck
4. Pull the top elastic loop over the head above the ears
5. Adjust the tie on the elastic as needed for a better fit

Your mask has been laundered prior to packaging.
